

FOREWORD



The Rayville Rosenwald, Rayville Colored High and finally Eula D. Britton High School had its beginning in 1907 south of Rayville, (the area known as the Brickyard). The school was known as the "College". Professor Amos was the President and instructors were: Professor and Mrs. Toombs, Delhi, Louisiana, Miss Elliot, Delhi, Louisiana, Professor J. Anthony, Rayville, Louisiana, and Professor P. J. Sims, Lincoln Parish. The students attending the College were enrolled in cooking, sewing, agriculture, music, Math and English courses. (Mrs. Jeanette McCaa Smith, who was a student at the College provided the above information).

Due to financial difficulties the college was dissolved and the next school for the Black children of the Rayville Community was held in the Macedonia Baptist Church.

Through the determined efforts of several leaders in the Black community to provide educational opportunities for the Black youth of Rayville the Odd Fellows Hall at the corner of Jewel and Pearl Streets was secured as a school. In October of 1916 the first school session was held with Professor Edward W. Beasley, Sr., of Houma, Louisiana as the new principal. Some years later Professor Jackson became the principal with Mrs. Clara Bell Coleman serving as the assistant and Mrs. Jackson as the third member of the faculty. The third principal serving during this time was Mrs. Ollie Hill of New Orleans with Mrs. Eula D. Britton, Mrs. O. S. Hill and Mrs. Evans as members of the faculty.

During the latter part of 1924 land was purchased from Mr. William Toliver Cook and grades 1-6 were transferred from Macedonia Baptist Church to the new school building, (present site of the Recreation Park). Mrs. Eula D. Britton was named the principal and the first graduates from the 7th grade held their graduation exercises at the Macedonia Baptist Church. Members of this first class were: Mrs. Mary Jenkins Kennedy, val., Mrs. Jessie Williams Gundy, sal., Mrs. Genva Cross, Mrs. Alberta Hawkins and Mrs. Alberta Osborne. The second graduates of the 7th grade (1925) held their exercises at the First Baptist Church.

In 1933 the school was approved as a Junior High School and in 1939 the first senior high school was approved with eleven young men and women receiving High School Diplomas from Rayville Rosenwald High School.

Through the years the growth of the school from the College to Eula D. Britton High School, (1956), was phenomenal. The original concept in 1907 until dissolution in 1970 was based on the need to provide educational opportunities for Black Citizens of Rayvillc. During the 63 years of its existence, unlimited efforts were made to ensure the perpetuation of an idea implanted in the minds of the early pioneers of the Black community.













The lower part of the first School building around 1919
